

An evening of Kenneth Anger's short films from the legendary Magick Lantern Cycle, including FIREWORKS (1947), RABBIT'S MOON (1950–71), and SCORPIO RISING (1964).

Kenneth Anger's enormously influential short films serve up a mind-bending cocktail of homoeroticism, symbolism and occultism, mixed with a

pioneering use of pop and classical music.

His controversial life and career – Anger also wrote trash-talking dumpster fire, Hollywood Babylon – are spiked with falsehoods, radicalism, censorship (leading to a landmark civil rights judgement), violence, and scandal.
